For phone service, each day is divided into four time slots (7 a.m. to noon; noon to 5 p.m.; 5 p.m. to 10 p.m.; 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.) Anyone with more than one year of sobriety can answer. The calls get forwarded directly to your phone. Training is provided. Caller I.D. reads "Alcoholics Anonymous."
